



Ministry Grant

The mission of this association of churches is to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to the lost world and to impact significantly the lostness in the Louisville Metro area for the glory of God.

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General Information

Purpose of Grant

The Louisville Regional Baptist Association (LRBA) is committed to supporting and empowering churches within our region to effectively engage and serve their communities with the gospel. Through the grant program, LRBA seeks to provide financial assistance to LRBA churches that demonstrate innovative and impactful initiatives aimed at fostering community engagement, outreach, and transformation.

Funding For Grant

The purpose of the Missions and Ministries Fund, the Urban Ministries Fund, and the Fred Tucker Offering is to support the activities of the Louisville Regional Baptist Association churches, their ministries, and Kingdom Partners by providing financial grants. The intention of the Association is to utilize these funds to empower LRBA churches, ministries, and Kingdom Partners to implement the Great Commission.

Missions and Ministry Fund

The Missions and Ministry Fund (MMF) has been established by the Louisville Regional Baptist Association (LRBA) for the distribution of earnings from the Missions and Ministry Endowment (MME) to LRBA churches, ministries, or partners serving anywhere in the Louisville Region.

Urban Ministries Fund

The Urban Ministries Fund (UMF) has been established by the Louisville Regional Baptist Association (LRBA) for the distribution of earnings from the Urban Ministries Endowment (UME) to LRBA churches, ministries, or partners serving Louisville's urban areas. These areas are defined as locations of ministry focus where the census tract data indicates that 15% or more of the population is below the poverty threshold.

Fred Tucker Offering (FTO)

The month of May has been designated to emphasize prayer and the annual offering for our Association's local mission work and for the missions and ministries with which we partner. The FTO is dedicated to the loving memory of Fred Tucker (1885-1963), for his 42 years of service to Louisville's inner-city, including 15 years as Pastor of East Baptist Church and 27 years with the Long Run Baptist Association (LRBA). The goal today is for Louisville Regional Baptist Association churches to assist in raising the needed funds for conducting Kingdom ministry in Louisville. By cooperating together, we are able to maximize our resources to reach the lostness of Louisville for Christ. The prayers offered during the FTO Season of Prayer and throughout the year are considered the most valuable resource given.

Grant Guidelines

Eligibility Criteria:

1. **Affiliation with LRBA:** Priority for grant funding will be given to churches affiliated with the Louisville Regional Baptist Association. Affiliation status will be verified prior to grant consideration.
2. **Non-Affiliated Churches/Ministries:** Churches/ministries in pursuit of affiliation, connected to an affiliated church, or of like-minded status may be considered for grant funds at the discretion of the Mission and Ministry Team. However, priority of funds will be given to affiliated churches.
3. **Doctrine:** For churches, there is agreement with an approved doctrinal statement of the LRBA (Baptist Faith and Message, Philadelphia Confession, or New Hampshire Confession), and/or answers to Theological Questionnaire.
4. **Project Alignment:** Proposed projects must align with LRBA's mission of community engagement and outreach. Projects require church participation. Projects may include but are not limited to:
 - Social services programs
 - Youth outreach and development initiatives
 - Education and literacy programs
 - Health and wellness initiatives
 - Community events and activities
 - Economic empowerment projects
 - Refugee Engagement
5. **Sustainability:** Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to the sustainability and long-term impact of their proposed project beyond the grant period.
6. **Returning Applicants:** Returning applicants must give evidence of effective use of previous funds or include an explanation as to limited effectiveness and expectation of improved effectiveness for the current grant cycle. In addition, returning applicants must have submitted all necessary reporting for previous grant cycle.
7. **Leadership:** Effective leadership is marked by integrity, collaboration, and accountability. Leaders operate under the authority of a Board or church, emphasize financial stewardship, and equip others to lead. They participate in peer accountability to strengthen their walk with Christ and ensure ministry relevancy.
8. **Applications must be postmarked or e-stamped by December 15.**
9. **A Federal Tax Identification Number must be provided.**

Grant Funding Criteria:

- Affiliation (25%)
- Evangelistic Focus (25%)
- Sustainability/Long-term Impact (25%)
- Church participation (10%)
- Feasibility (10%)
- Innovation (5%)

Application Process:

1. **Application Form:** Interested churches must complete the LRBA Grant Application Form, providing detailed information about the proposed project, including goals, objectives, budget, timeline, and expected outcomes.
2. **Supporting Documents:** Along with the application form, churches must submit any additional documents or materials that support their proposal, such as letters of support from community partners, project budgets, and relevant organizational information.
3. **Submission Deadline:** Applications must be postmarked or e-stamped by **December 15**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. **Review Process:** All applications will be reviewed by the Mission and Ministry Team of the LRBA. The team will evaluate each proposal based on its alignment with the grant guidelines, feasibility, impact, and potential for community engagement.
5. **Notification:** Churches will be notified of the status of their application within a reasonable timeframe following the review process. Successful applicants will receive further instructions regarding the disbursement of funds. Grants will be disbursed by no later than **March 31**.

Reporting Requirements:

1. **Progress Reports:** Grant recipients must be willing to submit progress reports to LRBA upon request, detailing the implementation and outcomes of their projects.
2. **Financial Accountability:** Churches must maintain accurate records of grant expenditures and provide financial reports upon request by LRBA.
3. **Final Evaluation:** At the conclusion of the grant period, churches must submit a final report summarizing the outcomes of the project, including any challenges encountered and lessons learned.
